Measures 4.5 cms long. Eye 3mm diam and was drilled from one side only causing some splintering as hole went through on opposite side. While trimming to a point the marrow cavity in the bone was exposed to form a very blunt hollow point. This end shows considerable signs of use.

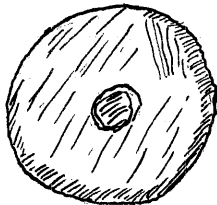
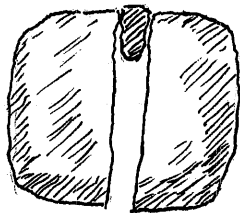
