An account of the excavations at this cave have appeared in the Proceedings, 1928;3,(2): 84 - 97 by E.K.Tratman and G.T.D. Henderson.

This account includes a general description of the cave and of the excavations and finds down to the top of the pleistocene.

In the upper most levels there was indication of occasional visits from modern times back to early bronze age or late neolithic times. This beaker period was represented by a definite hearth indicating more than casual visits and a definite period of occupation. It rested directly on and was partly cemented by stalagmite to the topmost portions of the underlying pleistocene deposits. An account of these has not yet been published, (1954). The deposits were remarkably barren but at a depth of five to six feet there were indications in the increasing number of remains that an occupation of sorts had taken place. Below this level very scanty remains



were found in the seventh and eighth feet of the pleistocene but below this down to eighteen feet nothing was found. ~~when it-~~
 At this level it was decided to abandon the excavations as in addition to the barrenness of the deposit there was great difficulty in the disposal of the spoil.

A notable feature in the lower parts was the presence of pieces of broken up stalagmite flooring in the deposit. A full report is to be issued.

The industry was of the Creswellian type and the fauna, subject to a detailed report, late pleistocene. MS-11/6

FIRST HEARTH HUMAN REMAINS.

From this level there are elements of the skeletons of three individuals (p. 87) with perhaps a fourth from another level. A child aged about 5-6years, a child aged about 10 - 12 years and a fairly old adult. These three are distinguished in the catalogue that follows by the numbers (1), (2), (3) below the actual catalogue number.

The First Hearth was formed during the occupation of the cave in the Neolithic - Beaker times about 2000 - 1800 B.C.

FIRST HEARTH.

Age as given by the teeth seems to be slightly lower than that given by the limb bones. Limb bones seem to indicate an age for individual (2) of about 13-15 years while teeth suggest 10 - 12 years. Teeth are probably more accurate guide.
