In 1925 information from a Miss Balch stated that the camp was being quarried away. A rescue dig was started the following year with the aid of a grant of £30 towards the cost of the work. The excavations were under the direction of Mr. J.A. Davies and Mr. C.W. Phillips. The report, "The Percy Sladen Memorial Fund Excavations at Bury Hill Camp, Winterbourne Down, Gloucestershire, 1926" was published in Proceedings of U.B.S.S. in 1927, 3 (1), 8-24.

Many of the finds were destroyed in 1940. A little remains (1974). Log Books and other records destroyed. Most of the photographic records were also destroyed but Dr. H. Taylor has re-photographed ~~many~~ some of his original prints so that there is a limited photographic record available. *See photographs 1926 by H. Taylor except where stated otherwise.*

Quarrying has now ceased (1974) and much of the site remains as it was in 1926. Some sites have gone. At least one rectangular hut site remains.
