- 8 $\frac{PM}{PM_1}$ Very extensive attrition buccally
Calculus adherent as band at cervical neck
mainly lingual
- 9 $\frac{I}{I}$ Traces of calculus at neck
- 10 $\frac{I^2}{I^2}$ Probably. Edge to edge bite
- 11 $\frac{C}{C}$ Prob left. Root grooved
- 12 $\frac{I^2}{I^2}$ Calculus adherent labially extending on to root
