Mr. A.M. ApSimon has prepared the following summary about the cave. He has also drawn a revised plan and section, which are on exhibition in Museum Case 3, top. He has also reported (1975, autumn) that bone material from the Platform - Mammoth Layer - was submitted to the Research Laboratory of the British Museum. The laboratory found that all the collagen in the bones had been destroyed and so the material was useless for C14 dating according to Dr. Plenderleith.

Summary

King Arthur's Cave was first excavated by the Rev. W.S. Symonds in 1871. Further excavations were made by University of Bristol Spelaeological Society between 1925 and 1930. (Proc. 1926, Vol. 2(3), Hewer and Proc. ~~3(2)~~ 3(2) Taylor). Since then work has been done to try to locate the deep part of the 1871 excavations but without success. Nearly all the material found by U.B.S.S. was destroyed in the war. [A few items are on exhibition in the Museum in case 3 top and case 4 top]

SUMMARY OF STRATIFICATION

(A.M.ApSimon)

LAYER

- 1. Surface soil:
- 2a. Mesolithic Hearth : frost weathering breccia with a fauna of Late-Glacial type. The hearth at the bottom of the layer produced a Late Upper Palaeolithic flint industry
- 3c. Mammoth Layer: transitional in composition between layers 2 and 3. Mammoth,wooly rhinoceros and Hyaena were in this level (= Proto-Solutrean layer in cave (?) but not above this level.
- 3. Upper Cave Earth. Red clayey earth completely decalcified with a fauna similar to the Lower Cave Earth of Symonds.
- 4. Red Sand. Calcareous,probably derived only from fissures in the limestone . Only found at back of cave.

LAYERS found by Symonds only.

- 5. Crystalline stalagmite
- 6. Lower Cave Earth the fauna included mammoth,wooly rhinoceros, megaloceros,bovids,and cave hyaena and cave lion.

CATALOGUES

There are two catalogues of objects found: neither seems (Jan.1976) to be complete for all items. The more complete one is in m.s form in a loose leaf folder (Room 7 - ~~rakes~~ racks. This was compiled by Dr.H. Taylor. The catalogue is in the main a running record of bones and teeth and other objects found and was made at the time of the excavations or soon after and on this respect is a form of Log Book.

This first catalogue forms the basis of the second catalogue on standard UBSS forms The second catalogue is far from complete. and for bones and teeth largely consists of entries of numbered specimens without identification except for some items. Some additional information as to layers is included.

Nov. 1975 - Jan. 1976. All the material from this cave was re-examined by E.K. Tratman. Mostly the material was bones and teeth as very little else survived the war.

All finds, except those on exhibition in the Museum, from the Old Spoil Heaps both outside and inside the cave were discarded as they could serve no useful purpose. Similarly many minute fragments of teeth and bones were deemed to be useless and discarded. All the teeth fragments belonged to animals represented by more complete material. The bone fragments were not identifiable as to species. This included some 'layered' material.

The soil samples were discarded as the paper bags containing them had ruptured and the soils were mixed

The collection of burnt flint implements, mostly small fragments, were all discarded as none could be matched to published illustrations

The balance of material has been bulked together under their stratified descriptions. The following sheets summarise the material. In most cases a summary label with the numbers of the specimens are included in the bags.


