This is the Tynings Farm group of barrows consisting of north, T10, South, T11, east, T12, west, T13, and central, T14. There is an additional one to the north in field N.N.W. of the farm T10A. Of these T10, 11, 13 and 14 have been completely excavated and T13 partially so. T10A has not been touched. Reports appear in Proc. U.B.S.S. 1924:2,(2):136ff. & 1933:4,(2):67ff. The latter contains an account of the full excavation of the north barrow. 1951:6,(2):111ff a full account of the south barrow. The excavations of the west and central barrows have not yet

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been published, 1954. T10A is an additional tumulus revealed when the rough ground to the north of the farm was brought under plough during the war%.

With the exception of T10A all these tumuli are marked on O.S. map 130- 1930 ed. T10A is not marked having been found since the revision.
