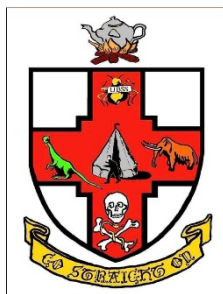

Guidance Notes:

In most cases it will be impossible to fund all applications, so priority will be given in the following order:

- Applications which further the aims of UBSS (the discovery, exploration and study of caves and their contents), with self-organised trips, those with historic links to the Society's work and those with scientific outputs scoring highly.
- Applicants joining or assisting with other established expeditions.
- Applicants going on 'tourist' caving trips organised within the Society where there will be an experience or training gain to participants
- Applicants joining caving 'holidays' organised by non-UBSS members.

In all cases, the production of outputs for one or more of the following (where applicable) will be a condition of any grants being awarded: UBSS website, *Proceedings* and *Newsletter*.
