

RAY MANSFIELD: A CONCISE CAVING BIBLIOGRAPHY

Abstract

An attempt is made to present a complete bibliography of the writings of Raymond Walter Mansfield (1942 – 2016). For details of some of his work see the appreciation in *Descent Magazine* No. 251, pages 36 – 37 (August /September 2016).

INTRODUCTION

This bibliography runs to over 125 titles. As will be apparent Ray wrote in many publications, and it is hoped that all have been located. He initially wrote about Mendip, and South Wales, but as the world “shrank” he developed world-wide interests. It is interesting to note that from an early date indexes and bibliographies became his speciality before he developed them to an altogether different level with Current Titles in Speleology (CTS).

As will be apparent from item No. 75 he also did a few, predominantly local, slide shows, unfortunately no definite information is known. The first was on ‘Flowers of the Sierra Nevada’ [USA] to Chewton Mendip Women’s Institute, probably in the spring of 1975 and probably briefly reported in the local press. Following the trip to SE Asia in 1982/3 he gave a number of talks (principally on China) to local Mendip organisations and caving clubs.

Not only did Ray never do anything by halves, I think we could add that he did not suffer fools gladly, certainly he never failed to tell me if he did not agree with something I had written. If you refer to reference Nos. 48 and 63 you will see what I mean.

From April 1976 and latterly when he was relinquishing his quarter century commitment to CTS he wrote extensively about philately, albeit primarily caves on postage stamps. These have been separated out and appear after the main bibliography.

He was variously a member of the Cotham Spelaeological Society (later Caving Group), the Mendip Nature Research Committee, Shepton Mallett Caving Club, Cave Diving Group, University of Bristol Spelaeological Society and I am grateful to UBSS for agreeing to publish this bibliography.

At the time of writing there is one item, reference No. 108, which is in preparation and yet to see the light of day. A few years ago Ray donated his Mammoth Cave record cards to the American Cave Research Foundation (CRF) thereby approximately doubling the number of historical accounts of which they were aware. It is anticipated that in due course “Bibliography of Mammoth Cave and Mammoth Cave Region” will be available on the CRF website to open access. Currently it is understood that there are around 7000 entries with a large backlog of additional material to be entered.
